

TROOP 118 PATROL ADVISOR PROGRAM

Troop 118 is a large troop with 50 to 80 boys active in eight or more patrols. Patrol Advisor Program was established to help ensure the patrols run smoothly. As Patrol Advisor, you need to be a regular participant in troop meetings and outings. If you cannot make some activities, utilize your mentors to act in your absence. You will participate in most of the patrol oriented activities, from patrol meetings to training exercises. A job description for the Patrol Advisor is as follows:

1. Train patrol leader in functions and duties of his leadership position.
2. Monitor patrol mentors to make sure they do their job.
3. Serve as a mentor for any patrol member who requests a Scoutmaster's conference and the Scout's mentor is absent.
4. Monitor performance of the Troop Guide to assure that he is fulfilling the elements of his job description.
5. Attend troop meetings regularly.
6. Attend outings regularly.
7. Attend patrol meetings.
8. Assist patrol leader in patrol's preparation for all assigned meeting duties and troop outings.
9. Visit with patrol on outings to assure that the outing is a positive experience for the entire patrol.
10. Advise Scoutmaster of any problems which exist within the patrol.
11. Promote "Scout Spirit".

If you decide you are unable to perform your duties as Patrol Advisor please let the Mentor Coordinator know as soon as possible so that your duties may be reassigned.
